PBC Foundation Level in Protective Behaviours

This is an engaging, participatory two-day course that provides learners with an excellent foundation in the internationally acclaimed Protective Behaviours Process.

The purpose of the course is to:

- Introduce participants to the principles and strategies of the Protective Behaviours Process
- Demonstrate how Protective Behaviours can be used to develop professional practice, support safer relationships, develop good safeguarding practice, and provide a safe approach to improving personal wellbeing.
- Enable learners to achieve an accredited Protective Behaviours Qualification (QCF).

Provided by the national organisation for Protective Behaviours, the course is delivered by leading experts in the field and aims to equip learners with sufficient knowledge and understanding to use the Protective Behaviours Process as part of their professional practice.

Feeling Safe: Knowing Me and Knowing You

This course is for professionals working with young people who have either experienced CSE or are at risk of CSE. It utilises the Protective Behaviours Process to facilitate learner centred workshops to individuals or groups of young people. KMKY provides practitioners with a toolkit and resources and includes the license to use and deliver the workshops. The training itself also allows professionals a safe place to explore how they can use PBs to keep themselves feeling safe when working on the front line.

The course is aimed at professional who have knowledge of CSE but are looking for a safe framework to provide support and intervention to the clients and young people they work with.

The course is provided flexibly so those who have not completed the Foundation Stage in Protective Behaviours can still access the course over 2 days. For those who have completed the foundation in PB the course can be accessed in 1 day.

The cost of the course includes the training, a copy of the toolkit and license.
